



DEPUY SPINAL RESEARCH FELLOWSHIP – 2007

The DePuy Spinal Research Fellowship is to promote research into clinical and basic science relevant to the practice of spinal surgery. The Award is for up to \$35,000. Additional earnings are allowed within the conditions of the Award.

Application for this Fellowship must include a Supervisor who is a member of the Spine Society of Australia. Preference will be given to clinical research, and to an Orthopaedic or Neurosurgical Fellow or a registered advanced surgical trainees.

Applicants will be required:

- (i) To have shown ability or promise of ability in research.
- (ii) To have made suitable arrangements with an established investigator under whose supervision the work is to be conducted.
- (iii) To show that the proposed topic of research is acceptable to the institution concerned.

The Fellowship is for twelve months and is normally tenable only within Australia or New Zealand.

The Award is for up to \$35,000. Additional earnings are allowed within the conditions of the Award. Closing date for application is the 1st March 2007

DEPUY SPINAL TRAVELING FELLOWSHIP – 2007

The DePuy Spinal Research Fellowship is to promote the practice of spinal surgery.

The grant is to fund a period of travel for a young spinal surgeon to visit centres involved in the treatment of, and/or research into spinal disorders. Travel may include attendance at notable international spinal meeting. The Fellowship provides funding for travel, accommodation, daily living expenses, and registration for attendance at notable meetings to a maximum of AUD 15,000.

Closing date for application for both Fellowships is the 30th March 2007
